Current guidance on the re-opening of businesses and social distancing within the workplace


The UK entered 'lockdown' on the 23rd March in order to limit the spread of Coronavirus. As part of the measures, many businesses were forced to close at that time and must remain closed. Some businesses however can operate under certain circumstances but must follow government guidance on social distancing.

Takeaway and delivery services may remain open and operational in line with government guidance. Online retail is still open and encouraged and postal and delivery services continue to run as normal.

For businesses which are able to operate during 'lockdown', government has provided guidance on social distancing in the workplace.

Reminder - Trafford Council encourages eligible companies to submit their grant applications; Trafford Council is calling upon eligible businesses across the borough to apply for their coronavirus grant support funding. Businesses who are yet to apply for the funding need to ensure they register and submit their bank details to the Council as soon as possible.

DWP support for employers and jobseekers: To assist businesses at this time the Department for Work and Pensions (DWP) is providing support to employers through Job Centre Plus. Reminder - Coronavirus Job Retention Scheme now open; A reminder that the government's Coronavirus Job Retention Scheme, which provides grants to organisations covering 80% of employee wages (up to a maximum of £2500
