

# **Retail Sector Update**

Today, the Secretary State for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy, Alok Sharma MP has written to the retail sector to acknowledge the difficulties being encountered by operators in the sector at this time. The letter outlines the government's thanks to those businesses which have closed in response to government direction. He also acknowledges the contribution of those workers in areas such as online distribution which are providing a vital lifeline for the isolated at this time. • Stimulating Employer Demand for Apprenticeships; The Growth Company is delivering the SEDA (Stimulating Employer Demand for Apprenticeships) project on behalf of GMCA (Greater Manchester Combined Authority). The project offers free workforce development planning and impartial advice around apprenticeships including funding and grants for non-levy paying employers looking to recruit new employees or upskill existing staff via apprenticeships. A Levy Matchmaking Service has also been developed which enables levy paying organisations who are not able to utilise their apprenticeship levy, to transfer it to an SME including charities, to fund the full training costs for apprenticeship training within their organisation. 
