Further to our call earlier this week for donations of unwanted PPE, we would like to say a huge thank you to those businesses and residents for their kind offers of support. We really appreciate it.


We have received a fantastic response from our community and businesses to this appeal. As a result we are dealing with a significant volume of emails and telephone calls.


Please be assured that we will forward your offer on to the relevant team, but be aware that due to high volumes we may not be able to respond to you immediately.

**Trafford Council encourages eligible companies to submit their grant applications**; Trafford Council is calling upon eligible businesses across the borough to apply for their coronavirus grant support funding. Businesses who are yet to apply for the funding need to ensure they register and submit their bank details to the Council as soon as possible.

Reminder - Coronavirus Job Retention Scheme now open; A reminder that the government's Coronavirus Job Retention Scheme, which provides grants to organisations covering 80% of employee wages (up to a maximum of £2500 per month) for a period of four months from the 1st March 2020, is now accepting applications.
